On October 14th 2019, the second Mutual Learning workshop under the topic of "Towards identification of measures and actions for successful Gender Equality Plans implementation within Research Performing Organisations (RPO)" took place in Ljubljana in collaboration between the Znanstvenoraziskovalni Center Slovenske Akademije Znanosti in Umetnosti (ZRC SAZU) and the Cyprus Neuroscience & Technology Institute (CNTI).
