Future Worlds Center announces a Call for Participation in a very interesting conference on gender issues that will take place in Salerno Italy on the 12th of July. The “Gender Equality policies and actions: Lessons. Impact. Sustainability” conference is organized back-to-back with the final meeting of H2020 project “Pilot experiences for improving gender equality in research organisations”, which will take place on the 11th. Interested people are invited to join either physically or virtually.

The Università Degli Studi di Salerno (UNISA) is the organizer of the final meeting, while the Brussels-based Digital Leadership Institute (DLI) is organizing the conference.

The R&I Peers project (<http://ripeers.eu>) is based on the concept of gender equality, that “women and men enjoy the same status and have equal opportunity to realize their full human rights and potential to contribute to national, political, economic, social and cultural development, and to benefit from the results”. The project had three objectives: (1)

Implementation and improvement of Gender Equality Plans (GEPs) in R&I-related organizations. (2) Smooth the gap of gender representation in decision-making and research-performing processes. (3) Maximize the impact and the efficacy of gender content in the research programs. The project extends across Italy, Cyprus, Spain, Israel, Belgium, Greece, and Slovenia.
