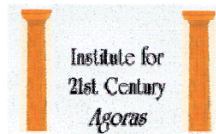
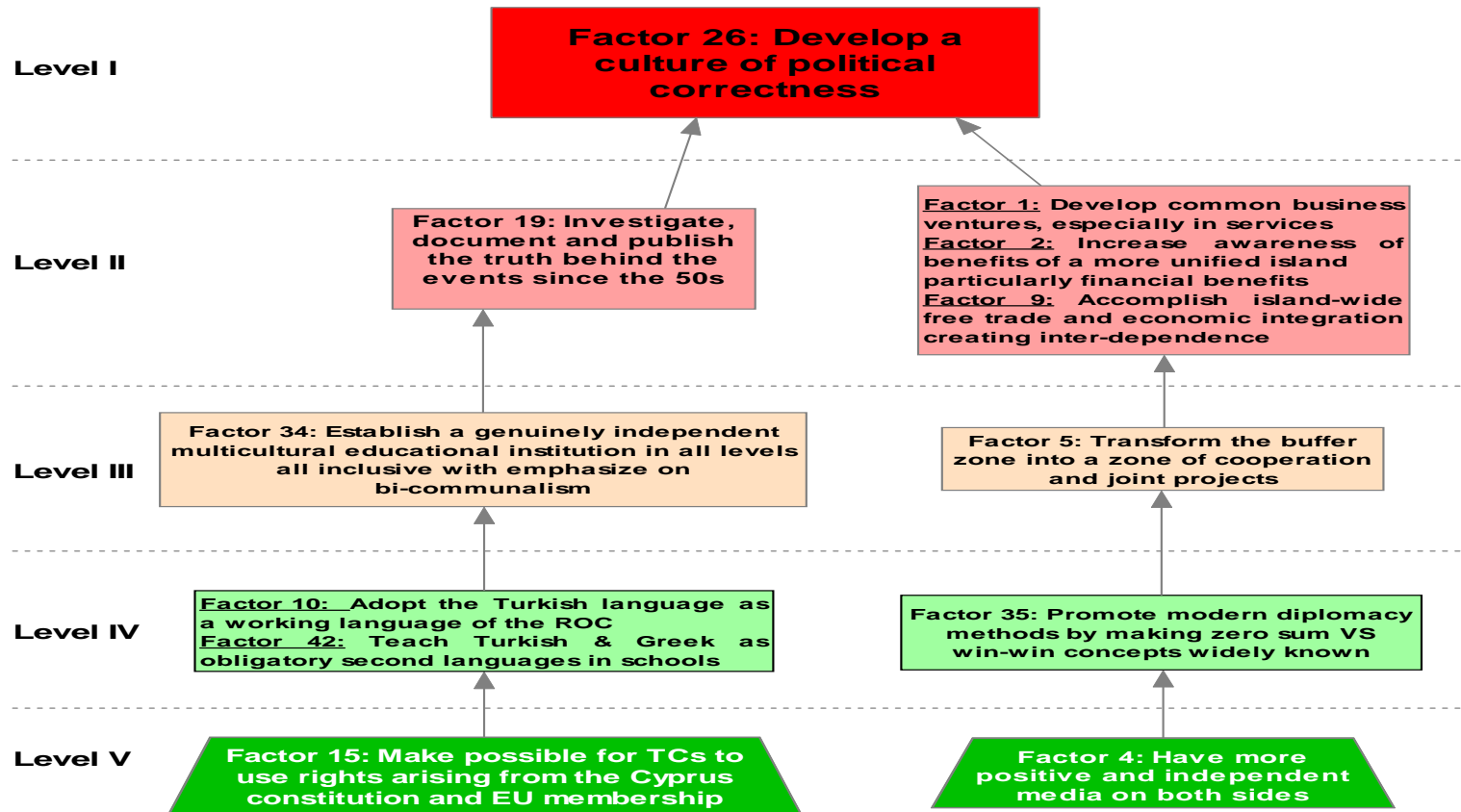


Deep drivers
